 - More profitable than Fan Cloth.
 - Propose a pre-show to take it over 2 hours so more concessions would be sold.
 - A parent suggested selling dinner before the show. If they serve dinner in the cafeteria then they have to pay the cafeteria workers.
 - "Jennifer and David do a good job turning a profit on concessions." Markham says that people are coming to the games just for concessions. People are paying for parking and tickets just to buy funnel cakes.
 - 75+ FSCs for participation in the fund-raiser.
