

BHS Band Booster Association Meeting November 8, 2011

A meeting of the Buckhorn High School Band Boosters was held on November 8, 2011, at 7:00 p.m. in the Band Room. Connie Glass, President, presided over the meeting.

I. General Announcements – Connie Glass

- A. Minutes - Minutes from the October 11, 2011, band booster meeting were emailed and parents voted to approve as submitted.
- B. Upcoming Events - An upcoming events handout was provided and will be reflected on the band website at www.buckhornband.com. Of special note is a change to the Christmas Concert, which has been moved from December 13th in the BHS gym to either December 19th or 20th at Columbia High School. Call time is 5:00 p.m. at Columbia High School and the concert will be at 6:30 p.m. The exact date will be announced as soon as possible. Dress is concert attire, black dresses and tuxes.

II. Financial Report – Dawn Wacaster

The Fall Band Fee is \$360 per student. Schedule of payments - \$90 was due by August 25th, \$90 due by September 15th, \$90 was due by October 15th, \$90 due by Nov 15th. Concession stand and clean-up profits, as well as proceeds from the EAA breakfasts will be entered into Charms student accounts very soon. The October budget with proposed and actual spending was provided. Reminder that Fall fees must be paid by December 10th. Spring band fees (Concert Band) are \$100 and credits remaining in student accounts will roll forward.
