Board member reports:

Sarah Posey, 1st VP: Read by Melanie Jackson: Slots for Chaperon's are open for last game and the competition. No ball game this week. In need of snacks for snack bags. We have plenty of chips. All bibbers will be washed after the Parade. Parade call time to be determined. Wanted to thank everyone who donated items for the pep rally meal. We will start planning the banquet in May and will be forming a committee soon. Need help picking up pallet of water before the next game. If anyone can help. David Donnelly indicated we have plenty of water in the concession stand and that we might not need the water.

David Donnelly, 2nd VP: one more game left and clean-up. A few slots open for concession stands for last game. Next month will establish concession stand clean-up and close.

Will not recommend using them again. Fund raising: middle of cookie dough sale which ends next Tuesday, October 30. Melanie will be in the band room on the 30th to collect forms and money. Thursday will be selling tickets to the Havoc hockey game on November 16th. Tickets are \$13.00. If we sell 100 tickets as a band the kids get \$5.00 in their band account. All sales are online. Will go live later this week. Melanie recommends you forward the email to friends and family to purchase tickets. Poinsettia sale starts this Friday organized by Stephanie Johnson. The information was posted to Facebook and will be emailed. The sales offer a very good profit for students. All the money goes into the student account. Mr. Souder has determined that fees are to be paid first from any profit the student makes and then can go to the Spring trip or fees for the 2019 marching fees. Forms will be in the band room on Friday. Student needs to collect the money when the order is taken. November 9th orders are due. Will be ready right before Thanksgiving. Still need to find a venue for the Christmas concert. Looking for a venue that is more cost effective for the budget. Needs to hold 300 people. Melanie will communicate food options for the third competition once finalized.
